

Chittenango Landing Canal Boat Museum: Winter Primary Source Program (Grade 4-6)

The 2 hour winter indoor program, Children of the Erie Canal, follows state regulations pertaining to use of primary sources as related to local and state history. Students study photos of children on the canal, compare and contrast artifacts of yesterday and today and examine a captain's ledger of 1877, write with ink and a feather pen. They will also experience chores performed by "canal kids" such as washing clothes in a tub, carrying water in a wooden bucket and beating a rug.
